### **Bangalore University**

Bangalore University was established in the year 1964 in the Garden City of Bangalore aptly hailed as the “I.T. Capital of India.” It was first accredited in 2002 by NAAC with Five Star Status and was re-accredited in the year 2016 with 'A' Grade. According to India Today - Nielsen survey of 31st May 2010, Bangalore University ranks 13th in the list of 50 top Universities in the Country. Academically, the University is structured into six faculties of Arts, Science, Commerce & Management, Education, Law and Engineering. It has 43 Post Graduate Departments; a post graduate Centre at Kolar and Ramanagaram, three constituent colleges, 665 affiliated colleges and several other Centres and Directorates of higher learning and research centres under its purview catering to a student population of over three lakhs. At present, University is headed by Prof. Dr. M. Muniraju, a renowned researcher and Scholar as Vice Chancellor and Prof. Dr. K. N. Ninge Gowda as its Registrar.

### **University Law College & P.G. Department of Law**

University Law College - a Centre of excellence for legal learning in India was first started by the then Government of Mysore in the year 1948. Initially affiliated to the University of Mysore, University Law College was known as Government Law College. It boasts of many legal luminaries like Justice M. N. Venkatachalaiah, Former Chief Justice, Supreme Court of India; Justice N. Santosh Hegde, Former Judge, Supreme Court of India and Lokayukta, Karnataka State; Justice R.

Raveendran, Former Judge, Supreme Court of India and a host of other Judges of High Courts and eminent Advocates and outstanding politicians like Shri. S.M. Krishna & Shri. S. Bangarappa, Shri. M. Veerappa Moily, the former Union Law Minister, all former Chief Ministers of Karnataka as well as others in administration. Recently five alumni are designated as Senior Advocates of High Court of Karnataka. After the establishment of Bangalore University, it became part of Bangalore University and was named as University Law College. University Law College is the pioneer in introducing the Five year LL.B integrated program in the year 1986 – 87. It has a Post Graduate Department of Studies in Law and has been offering One Year LL.M programme in Corporate and Commercial Law, Constitutional and Administrative Law, Criminal Law, Environmental Law and Human Rights and Labour and Employment Law from the academic year 2014-15.

Presently, it is headed by **Prof. Dr. V. Sudesh** as Principal, Dean and Chairman, P.G. Dept. of Law and has six permanent faculties apart from few Full time & Part Time guest faculty members.

### **About the Seminar:**

The concept of social justice consists of diverse principles essential for the orderly growth and development of personality of every citizen. Social Justice is thus an integral part of justice in the generic sense. Social Justice is dynamic devise to mitigate the sufferings of the poor, weak, tribals’ and deprived sections of the society and to elevate them to the level of equality to live a life with dignity of persons.

The compelling social situation led to the creation of special provisions in the Constitution for the advancement of socially and economically backward classes of citizens. The positive discrimination was thought of as a policy mechanism to realize the social goals set before the nation and as means by which the backward citizens could reach the mainstream to achieve social justice. Indian Judiciary has played a pivotal role to make the dream of Social Justice a reality and to prove it is a boon for the common. ‘In other words, the aim of Social Justice is to attain substantial degree of

social, economic and political equality, which is the legitimate expectation and constitutional goal.

Globalisation refers to different social processes that have a global reach. To demarcate the concept it refers to processes and relations like social, economic, political, cultural etc. Economic globalisation is probably the most important single globalisation it intensified the world-wide economic relations. As a consequence it is arbitrary to let national borders delimit social ethical reasoning and discussions about justice.

As economic globalisation affects how wealth and power is globally distributed, it has become necessary to discuss social ethics in a global context and to develop principles of global justice. It implies global interdependence, which challenges the “methodological territorialism” of many theories of justice.
