I ELIGIBILITY

I . No candidate shall be eligible for appearing in the Admission Test and to seek admission to One Year Post-Graduate Degree Programme in Law (LL.M-Semester Scheme) unless he/she has passed with **not less than 50% marks [5% relaxation for SC/ST, Category I and differently abled candidates]** in the aggregate of 3yrs/5yrs LL.B degree examination conducted by Bangalore University or any other University recognized by UGC leading to the award of LL.B Degree.

II . Merit List of the candidates for the purpose of admission to One Year Post-Graduate Degree Programme in Law (LL.M-Semester Scheme) shall be based on the criteria of assessment for selection of candidates as specified below:

- i) 50% of the marks secured by the candidate in All India Admission Test &
- ii) 50% of the marks obtained in LL.B Degree 3/5 Years (Aggregate)

II NO. OF SEATS

The number of candidates to be admitted to the One Year Post-Graduate Degree Programme in Law (LL.M – Semester Scheme) shall be 08 (Regular Seats) and 2 (Payment Seats) in the following branch of specialization:

- 1. Constitutional and Administrative Law**
- 2. Corporate and Commercial Law**
- 3. Labour and Employment Law**

RESERVATION OF SEATS

The admission of the candidates shall be based on merit cum reservation policy of the State Government/Rules of Bangalore University with regard to Supernummary seats issued from time to time.

A foreign student from other than English speaking countries seeking admission to One Year Post Graduate Degree Programme in Law (LL.M-Semester Scheme) shall have completed to TOEFEL or other equivalent exam from fulfilling the minimum eligibility conditions. However, he/she shall be exempted from the admission test.

III HOW TO APPLY

- a) Candidates eligible as per eligibility requirements may download applications forms online from www.bangaloreuniversity.ac.in or www.ulcbangalore.com
- b) Duly filled in applications in all respects must reach the Office of the Principal/Chairman, University Law College, Dept. of studies in Law, JnanaBharathi Campus, Bangalore University, Bengaluru-560 056 either in person or by post before the last date of submission.
- c) Entrance test question will be based on multiple choice questions for 100 marks (50 questions, each question carrying 2 marks)
