Introduction

The Government Law College, Bangalore was established by the erstwhile Government of Mysore on July 1st 1948. The Government Law College was transferred to Bangalore University and since then the college is known as University Law College, as a Constituent College by an order dated 19-6-1976. The University Law College, Bangalore has been offering 5 years LLB integrated programme since the year 1986-87. In 2019 five years BA LLB Honours is introduced. The Master Degree Programme in Law was started in the year 1960-61 as LLM Post graduate course at present LLM (2 years) Post graduation in Five specialized branches are offered.

Brief Information about Library

The library was established in the year 1948 along with the Government Law College. It was housed in a little room of the college with a few books. Later on, an exclusive area was provided for the library. Gradually, the library has been equipped with additional books and journals. After shifting of ULC from the city campus to the Jnana Bharathi Campus, the Library has been built up in an independent well-planned building, steadily over the years with books from a wide range of subjects, such as language, social Science and connected areas, including text books, reference books, books on literature, rare books, journals, manual and digests as well as current legal periodicals apart from law books.

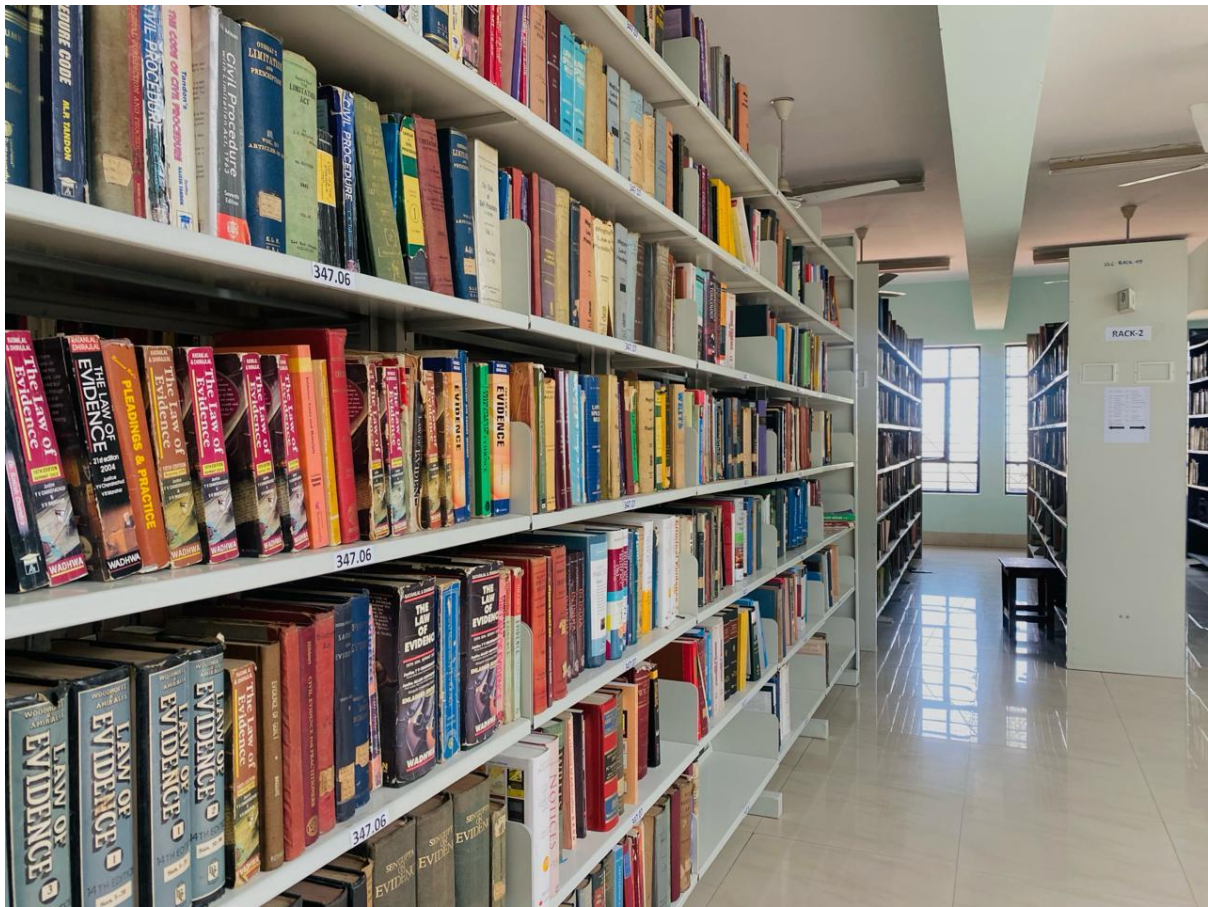

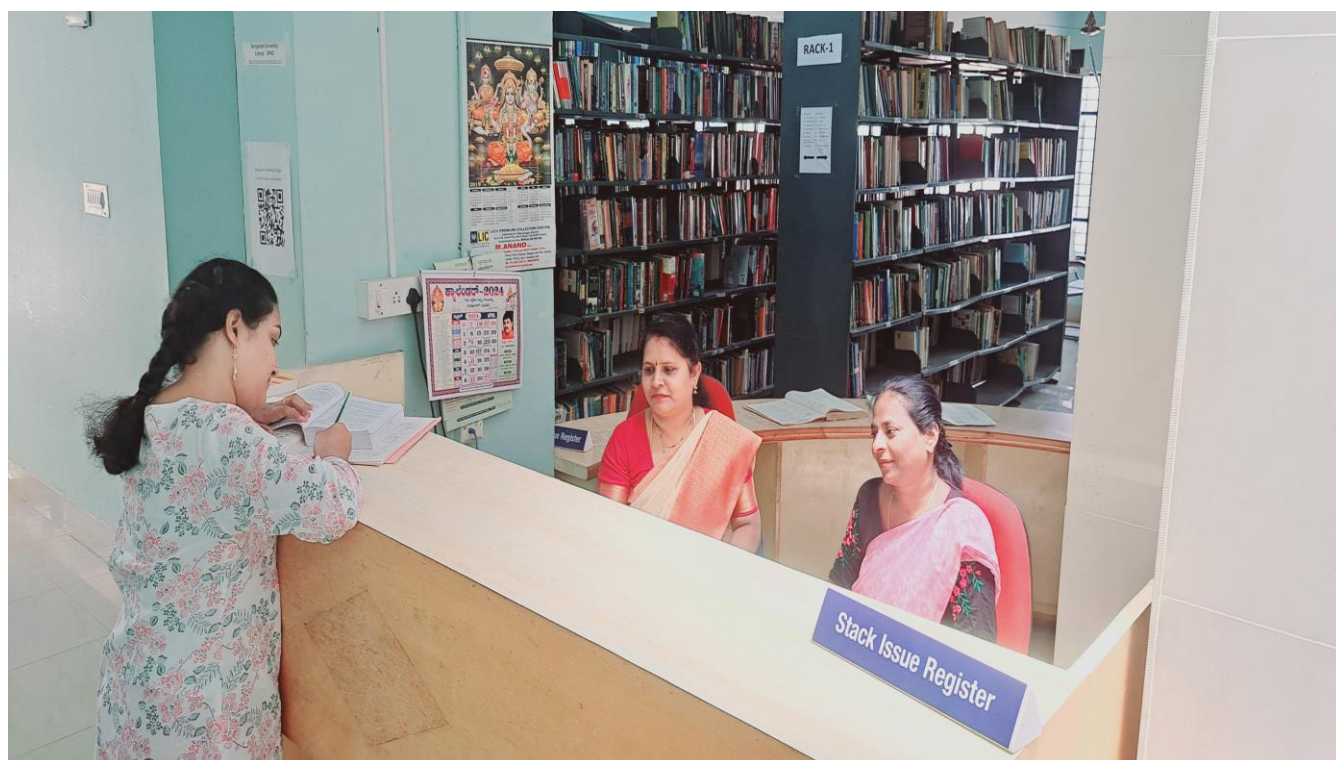


The library uses KOHA Library Management System, and the operations of Cataloguing, Circulation and Serial Control have been automated. Resources are updated on a regular basis.

Rules for Borrowing Books

- Stack books for 15 days and Reference books for one day to the students will be issued against their I-Card;
- Book Banks for SC/ST Students can borrow 4 books at a time and can be retain for the entire semester;
- Students can borrow the books to all the semester except LLB Students of 10th Semester and LLM students of 4th Semester;

- Check the book at the time of issuing. In case of any defect or damage please inform the library staff;
- Return the issued books on or before the due date;
- Late fee charged at Rs. 2/- per text book and Rs.5/- for reference book per day;
- Journals, Dictionaries, Hand Books, Encyclopaedia, magazines/thesis & project reports/maps will not be issued outside the library;
- In case of lost or damage of book, replacement of book has to be made by the user.

Rules relating to Loss of Books

- The Users who lose the book must report the library immediately. He/She will be given one month's time for finding and return the books;
- In case he/she fails to return the books after one month from the date of reporting. He/she will be charged a fine of Rs. 2/- per day per text book and Rs. 5/-per day reference book and he/she replaces it with the new book of the same title and other details;
- In case he/she cannot replace the book, then he/she will have to pay Four Times the cost of book subject to the minimum of Rs. 500/- if the cost of the book is less than Rs. 125/-;
- The present conversion rates will be counted for foreign books;
- Replacement by photocopied version will not be accepted.

No Due Certificate

- No Due Certificate for the LLB and LLM students will be issued for the Last Semester i.e. LLB course 10th Semester and LLM Course 4th Semester before receiving the Hall ticket;
- Research Scholars will be issued No Due Certificate before Submission of the Thesis.

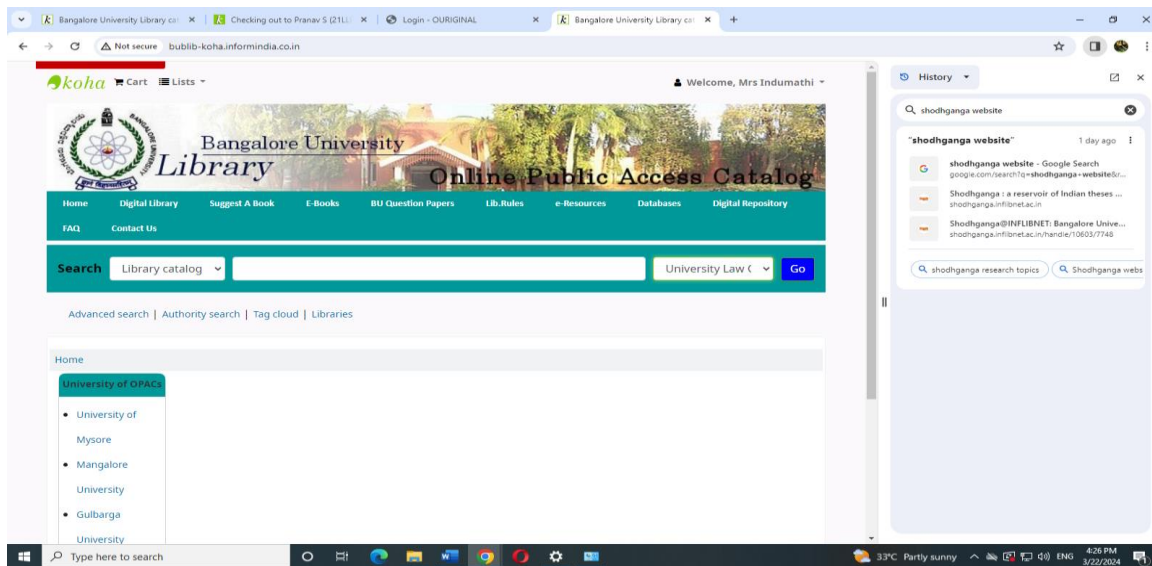
Cyber Lab:
